

Credits by Grade Level

The grade level of high school students is determined solely upon the number of credits earned while in high school.

9th Grade = Less than 55 Credits

10th Grade = 55 to 109 Credits

11th Grade = 110 to 169 Credits

12th Grade = 170+ Credits

To graduate, students need to earn 230 credits, pass the California High School Exit Exam, complete service learning, identify a career pathway, and show computer proficiency.
