COWAN AVENUE ELEMENTARY ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

Music Program

Cowan Avenue Booster Club supports a weekly music enrichment program for grades 2-5. The music program includes a wide range of music exposure and theory, incorporating music from around the world. Our upper grades 4 & 5 have the option of joining the Cowan Choir. In addition this program is extended to our lower grades K & 1 for our Holiday program and Spring concert.

Physical Education

Each grade receives one hour of instruction in Physical Education. In addition to fitness as a goal our children are exposed to a variety of sports and games. This program also enables our teachers to have an hour of grade level planning time.

Computer Lab

Cowan's computer lab has a dedicated instructor and offers instruction for grades 2-5. Our students visit the computer lab once a week where they learn computer skills that are then incorporated into their curriculum.

Learning Lab

The goal of the Learning Lab is to provide immediate and targeted intervention for students in grades K-5 who are not meeting grade level standards in one or more of the key academic areas of reading, writing and math. This early intervention gives the student the help they need before they fall too far behind.

Academic Challenge

Cowan's newest enrichment program for grades 3-5. Students participate in areas of academics similar to the high school's decathlon except they aren't competing against each other. The primary goal of the program is to provide a FUN and EXCITING way to challenge our students academically. The areas last year were Geography, Mathematics, Reading Comprehension, Astronomy, Spelling Bee & the Super Quiz. The program takes place over a few months and results in a team event Super Quiz and a fun filled awards night! Learning has never been this much fun!

Model UN

This is a 4th & 5th grade enrichment opportunity where students will explore various countries and world issues such as women and children rights, global health issues, and building global partnerships. Students will culminate the course with a presentation and mock UN assembly.
