<b>Rate 2</b>	Limited to certificated non-management employees for training activities designed to improve the general educational program. May require limited outside preparation by the trainee.	<b>20.00</b>	<b>2.11</b>	<b>22.11</b>
<b>Rate 3</b>	Limited to classified employees for training activities designed to improve the general educational program. May require limited outside preparation by the trainee.	<b>10.00</b>	<b>0.87</b>	<b>10.87</b>
