SUBJECT: RELEASE OF THE 2008 API and AYP RESULTS

Attached is the board informative with the 2008 API and AYP results that will be released Thursday morning at 10:30 a.m. I am pleased to share good news with you about the progress that is being made at our schools. There is much to be proud of and I commend our students, teachers, administrators and staff for their hard work.

Here are a few of the highlights of the API scores:

- The District's API growth of 21 points exceeded the state's growth of 14 points. At every level of schooling, LAUSD's growth exceeded the state. Elementary schools increased 34 points from the previous year compared to California's growth of 13 points. Middle schools increased 32 points, compared to 15 points for California. LAUSD high schools increased by 22 points, compared to 13 points for California.
- Each of the major subgroups increased by double digits, except for Pacific Islanders. English Learners increased by 15 points and Students with Disabilities increased by 16 points.
- The number of schools with an API score of 800 or above has increased from 111 schools (18%) last year to 147 schools (24%) this year. The number of schools with API scores of 550 or less has narrowed to only 12%.
- More than half of LAUSD schools (55%) met their growth targets. Among schools that did not meet growth targets, 31% experienced growth in their API, compared to 22% statewide. Among our lowest scoring schools (Decile 1 and 2), only 8% had API scores that declined or remained the same, compared to 21% statewide.

While I am pleased with the academic progress of our schools, it should be noted that several schools did not receive an API score because not enough students were tested. Local District Superintendents and principals need to understand that not testing all students is not acceptable and cheats students of educational opportunities. I want to ensure that this does not happen in the 2008-09 school year.

In terms of the federal accountability results (AYP), the bar for proficiency percentages was raised this year and will continue to increase each year until 2014. Although the District did not meet AYP targets, there was an increase in the percent of students scoring proficient and advanced for each of our major subgroups. The District met the graduation rate criterion for the first time since 2003. The trajectory is in the right direction. One of the flaws of the No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act is that even when schools make progress, the bar continually moves higher. While it may be demoralizing for students and for staff, I encourage all schools to continue to improve.

It is imperative that all schools and staff understand the API and AYP data and its importance in instructional decision-making. Please call Cynthia Lim, Interim Assistant Superintendent of Planning and Assessment if you would like assistance in working with your staff regarding data.

There is much to be proud of and there is more work that needs to be done. The test results show that we can make progress when students, teachers, administrators and parents work in a concerted effort. I commend you on your hard work.

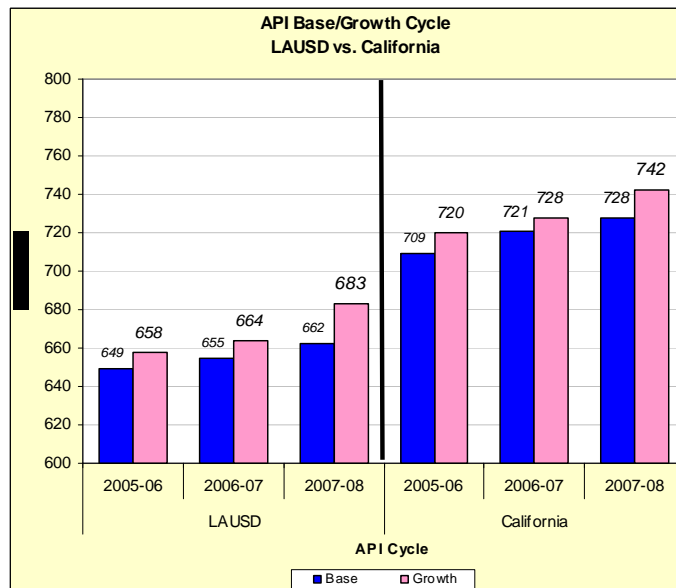
The information contained in this informative is embargoed until Thursday, September 4, 2008, 10:30 a.m. when the California Department of Education (CDE) releases the 2008 Accountability Progress Report on their website at <http://www.cde.ca.gov/apr/>.

The Accountability Progress Report provides schools and districts information regarding progress on the state Academic Performance Index (API) and results on the federal 2008 Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP). The API and AYP convert test results into different measures of academic performance. The API is part of the state accountability system which measures growth in school performance across multiple subject areas. The federal AYP looks at the percentage of students scoring proficient or above. The *No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB)* requires states to provide Adequate Yearly Progress results at the beginning of the school year so that schools and districts can implement required services.

2007-08 API GROWTH (STATE ACCOUNTABILITY)

The API growth for LAUSD increased from a base of 662 in 2007 to 683 in 2008, a growth of 21 points. Figure 1 shows that LAUSD's growth of 21 points was higher than the overall state growth of 14 points, continuing an upward trend in growth scores since 2005-06.

Figure 1: API Base and Growth for LAUSD and California



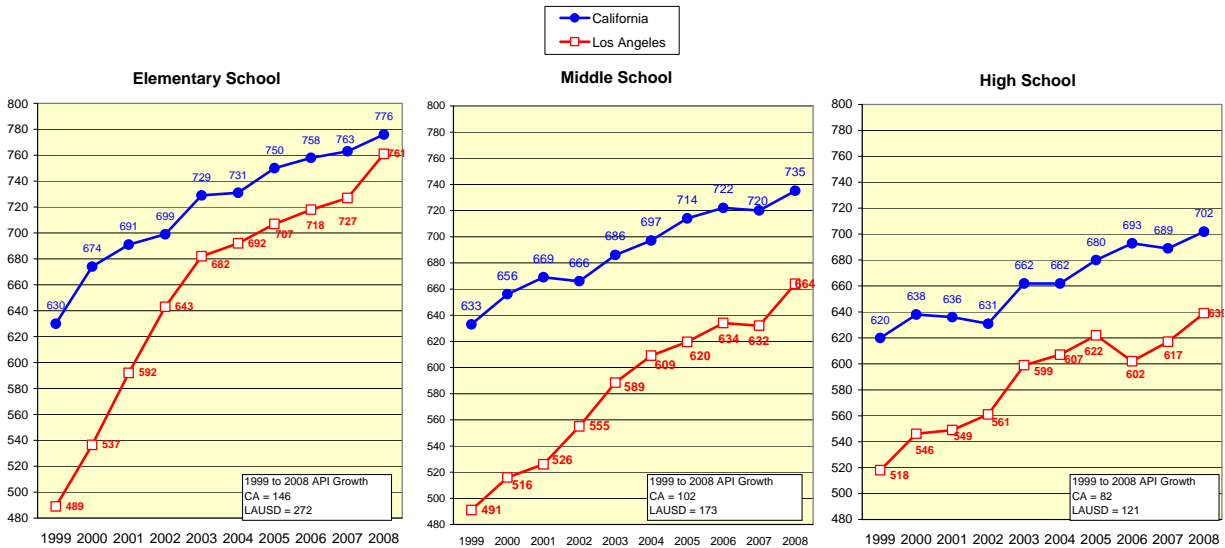
When examined by schooling level, LAUSD elementary schools continue to outpace California in increasing their API scores. Figure 2 shows that LAUSD elementary schools increased 34 points over the previous year while California increased 13 points. Over the past 8 years, LAUSD elementary schools

increased from 489 in 1999 to 761 in 2008, a growth of 272 points while California had a growth of 146 points.

From 2007 to 2008, LAUSD middle schools increased API growth scores by 32 points, twice as high as the 15 point increase in middle schools across California. Over the past 8 years, LAUSD middle schools increased from 491 in 1999 to 664 in 2007, a growth of 173 points compared to 102 points for California.

LAUSD high schools increased 22 points from 2007 to 2008, compared to a 13 point increase for high schools across California. Over the past 8 years, LAUSD high schools increased from 518 in 1999 to 639 in 2008, a growth of 121 points compared to 82 points for California.

All LAUSD subgroups increased their Growth API scores, as displayed in Table 1. Highlights include:

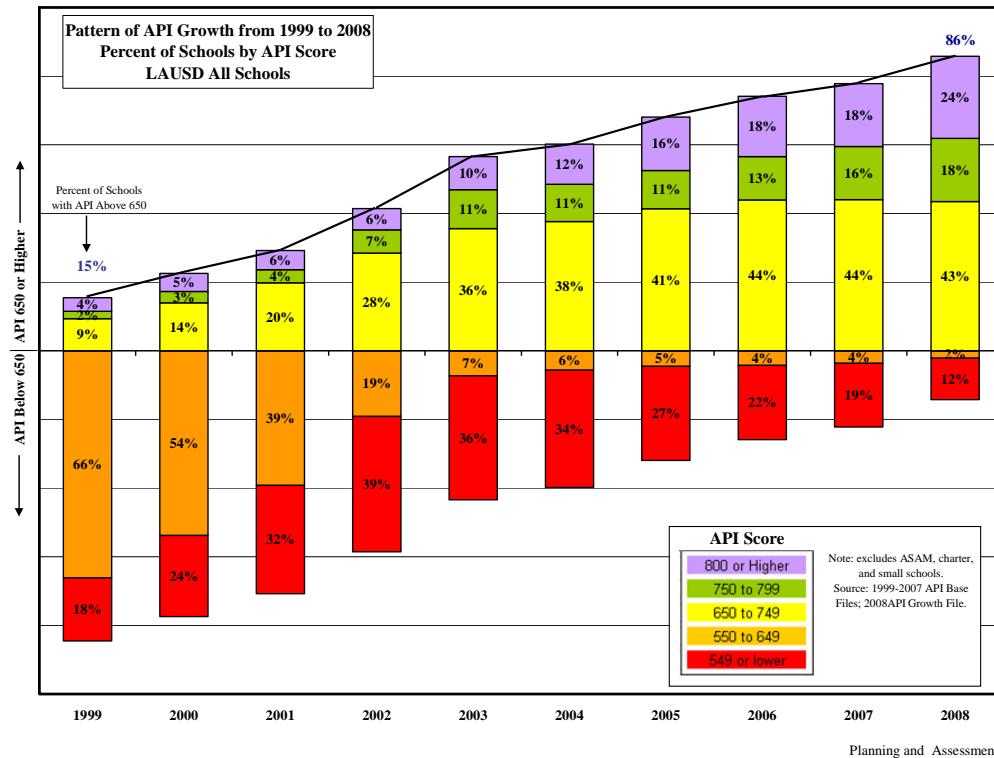
- The American Indian or Alaska Native and Hispanic subgroups had the greatest increase with 24 and 22 points, respectively.
- The socio-economically disadvantaged subgroup increased by 21 points.
- The African American subgroup increased by 19 points.
- The English learners increased by 15 points.
- Students with disabilities increased by 16 points.

The percentage of schools scoring an API of 650 or higher continues to increase. In 2008, 86% of LAUSD schools have an API score of 650 or higher compared to 15% in 1999. Figure 3 displays the percentage of schools by Growth API scores since 1999.

Figure 3: Pattern of Growth API from 1999 to 2008



In 2008, the number of schools who met the state's performance goal of 800 has increased from 111 in 2007 to 147 in 2008. Attachment A lists the schools scoring 800 or above.

Growth Targets

More than half of LAUSD schools met their API targets (55%) in 2008 compared to 54% statewide. Table 2 also shows that LAUSD had a higher percentage of schools (31%) that experienced growth in their API but did not meet their targets compared to the State (22%). LAUSD had a lower percentage of schools (14%) where their API remained the same or declined, compared to the State (24%).

When comparing Decile 1 and 2 schools within LAUSD and the State, similar percentages of schools met API targets. However, 38% of LAUSD Decile 1 and 2 schools experienced growth in their API, compared to 24% in the State. Far fewer Decile 1 and 2 schools in LAUSD remained the same or declined in their API (8%), compared to the State (21%).

Attachment B is a district list of schools showing their Schoolwide Growth API from 2007 to 2008 and whether they met their API criteria for each of the required components. Seven senior high schools did not receive a Growth API score, due to participation rates lower than 85% in Science or Social Science:

- Carson SH
- Crenshaw SH
- Hamilton SH
- Los Angeles SH
- Manual Arts SH
- South East SH
- Washington Prep SH

2008 ADEQUATE YEARLY PROGRESS (FEDERAL ACCOUNTABILITY)

There are four main components to meeting Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP):

1. Participation rate in English language arts and Math of 95% or greater
2. Percent proficient in English language arts and Math
3. API
4. Graduation rate (high schools only)

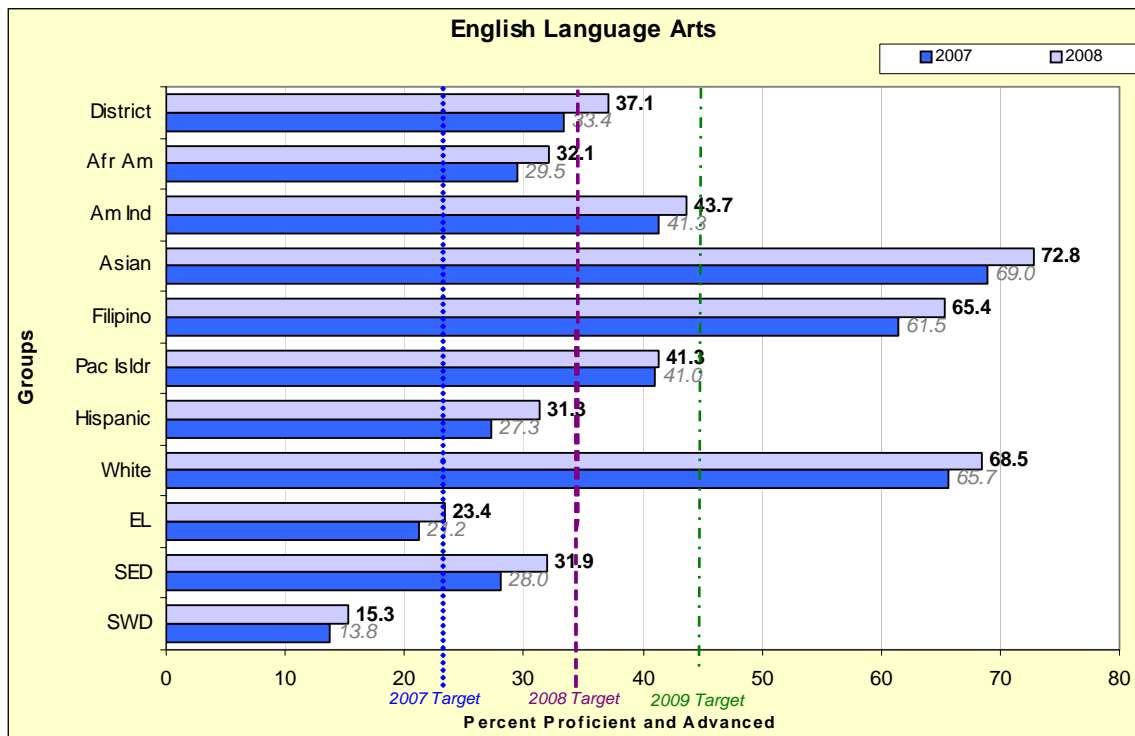
In the 2007-08 school year, the targets for percent proficient and the minimum API requirement increased. The targets for proficiency increased to 34.0% in English language arts and 34.6% in math. Beginning this year, the targets will increase yearly until they reach 100% in 2013-14. To meet the API requirement for AYP purposes, the school or district must demonstrate growth of at least one point or have a minimum score of at least 620, an increase from 590 in previous years.

A school district may have up to 46 requirements to meet all AYP criteria. LAUSD met 38 of its 46 AYP criteria. The following criteria were not met:

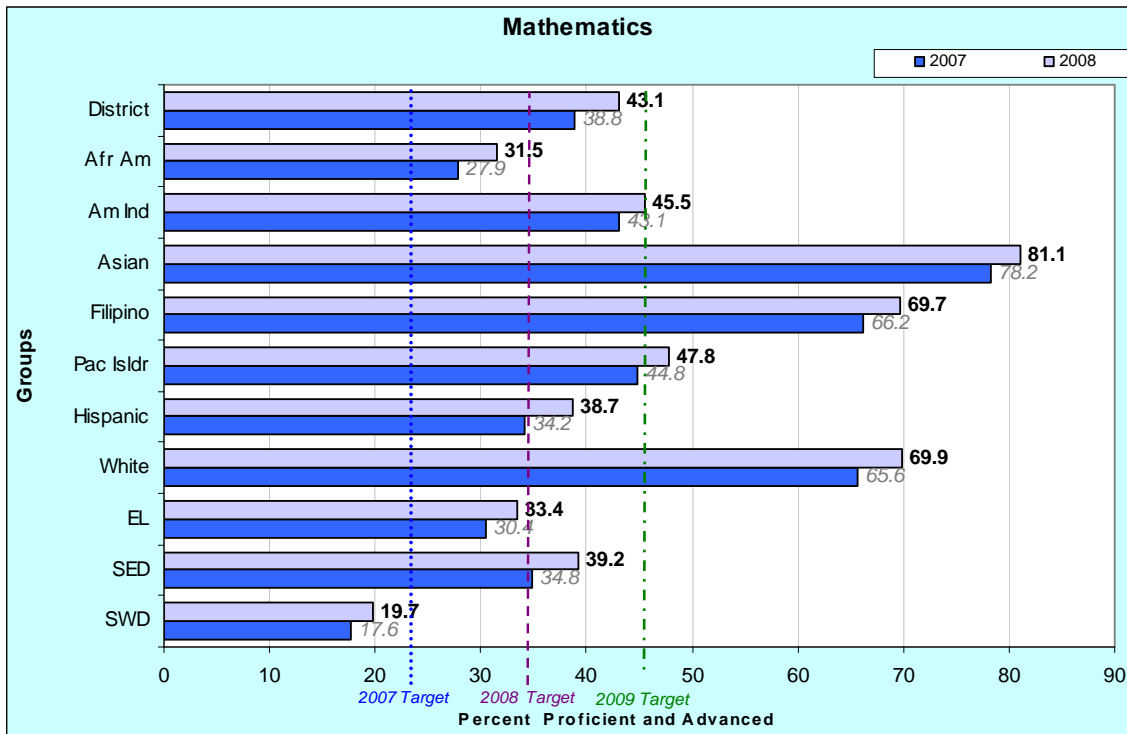
- AYP target of 34% proficient in English language arts -- LAUSD African Americans, Hispanics, Socio-economically Disadvantaged, English learners and Students with Disabilities did not meet this criterion. Figure 4 shows that while each of these subgroups increased the percent of students scoring proficient and advanced, the growth was not high enough to reach the increased target.
- AYP target of 34.6% proficient in Mathematics – LAUSD African Americans, English Learners and Students with Disabilities did not meet this criterion. Although every subgroup increased the percentage of students scoring proficient and advanced, African Americans, English Learners and Students with Disabilities did not reach the targeted proficiency rate. See Figure 5.

Because we did not meet these criteria, LAUSD is advancing to Program Improvement (PI) Year 3. Detailed information about Program Improvement schools will be sent in a separate informative.

Graduation Rate

LAUSD met the AYP graduation rate criterion with an increase of 2.5%. This is the first time that LAUSD has met the graduation criterion. The AYP graduation criterion requires an 83.0% graduation rate, or +0.1% one-year change, or +0.2% two-year average. Table 3 displays LAUSD’s graduation rate, which increased from 62.8 in 2007 to 65.3 in 2008. It should be noted that the graduation rate on the 2008 AYP report is for the class of 2006-07. The graduation rate for the class of 2007-08 will not be reported for AYP purposes until the 2009 report.
