The end of an era occurred on Feb. 3, 2006, at Narbonne High School.

Gerald Zwick conducted his FINAL Final Exam in Exploratory Work Experience after 20 years and 40 classes. Jerry has been providing the students of LAUSD lessons and credits for work experience for the past 20 years. Lessons included topics in job development, resume writing, interviewing skills, soft skills on keeping a job, looking for community resources, and using the local phone book.

The Final Exam consisted of an oral interview given by volunteers from the staff and in front of members of the work experience class. Interviews are taped and reviewed by the classes. Students discussed items regarding their strengths, what could be improved on, and if they would hire the interviewee. Students are expected to dress for an interview and conduct themselves in a professional manner; this included asking questions concerning the job and items of concerns. The last classes consisted of thirteen students from all disabilities and included three students in wheel chairs.
