# Minutes Taken by Flora Obie

The meeting was opened by Gloria Powel making a motion. Peggy Jones mad e a second to the meeting to open. The meeting began at 9:10 a.m.

The Chairperson Julie Burg led the group to a flag salute. The secretary called the roll of members.

Welcome and Introductions were made.

Mr. McKenna said: Children are our most precious things in the world. Our schools are judged by a lot of things. They are judged by our neighborhood. I have a vision for District 7. He wants to pair parents that are doing well with their children to help those parents that are not doing well with their children in terms of discipline. He said that we as parents need to be willing to help ourselves. He wants a meeting with the parents of kids doing well. He wants us to ask these parents if they would be willing to help parents of those kids not doing will. He wants them to be paired up.

He spoke about the Educational Civil Rights Agenda. Support for parents of underachieving children is needed. Only 2% of teachers are Black men and less than that are latino male teachers in America.

Every middle and High School should have a future teacher club in their school.

He asked. Are we willing to care about people?

## Second Vision of Dr. McKenna:

SB3782 is a bill authored by him. This bill has been watered down. Parents have a right to take time off work to participate in their child's school. He then asked about surveying students. He would want questions on the survey. For instance, question number 9 might ask. If you were to go to church, what church would you go to? Then go to that church pastor and ask the pastor if he would want to help those kids in counseling their parents. None of this is easy.

The PCAC Vision and Mission was reviewed. Dr. Mckenna asked for parents to ask questions they may have of him. Dr. McKenna solicited questions and concerns. Every parent that shared had two minutes. Some concerns were addressed by Dr. McKenna. He offered to stay after the meeting to talk to those parents that had concerns.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:20 a.m.
